

Environmental Site Assessment

The Coca-Cola Company – Skikda, Algeria



EDESSA was retained by **COCA-COLA MIDDLE EAST AND NORTH AFRICA** in order to conduct an *Environmental Site Assessment* of the Skikda facility in the industrial zone of Hammadi Krouma, Algeria. This facility is being acquired by Skikda Bottling Company (SBC) and where a new bottling plant is to be constructed. The purpose of this Environmental Site Assessment is to review past and present on-site and off-site land use, and to evaluate the potential environmental impacts which might be caused from operating the planned bottling facility.

Recommendations made in this report regarding the proposed development were made to provide Coca-Cola with the basis of a proper design in terms of secondary containment of hazardous waste and management of solid and liquid waste.

The Environmental Site Assessment is to:

- Review past and present land use practices;
- Examine site activities and nearby offsite land uses;
- Evaluate the potential of soil and/or groundwater contamination;
- Recommend environmental considerations to be included in the design of the new facility that is planned to be built on this site in order to be in compliance with the environmental regulations of Algeria and the Coca-Cola Environmental Management policies.
